Hello Roosevelt Community,

I hope this message finds you and your family well in this new year. Our team continues to monitor Covid-19 data and additional variables in our community in order to determine when to offer an in-person learning experience. We have been meeting weekly with staff throughout the district to plan a safe hybrid and/or in-person return to school. To keep our students, families and community safe, we have implemented safety protocols throughout the district. Additionally, we have equipped our school nurses with the necessary PPE, purchased air purifiers, hosted COVID-19 vaccination opportunities for educators, developed a custodial support manual with deep cleaning protocols and provided each school with safety signage to ensure all students and staff understand and adhere to CDC guidelines.

For now, we believe that it is the right decision for our school district to remain in an all-virtual learning setting until at least after spring break. We understand the importance of in-person learning and are committed to offering an experience once it is appropriate to do so. Over the next few weeks, data and additional variables will be evaluated and follow-up information about in-person learning options will be provided to families in March.

We remain committed to providing a high-quality student experience and ongoing support with meals, broader on-site care support at all schools and technology/internet support. Most recently, we have deployed buses equipped with Wi-Fi hotspots throughout the community. They will be parked at El Prado, Ma-Ha Tauk, Circle K, and Nueve parks from 8:15 a.m. to 2 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please reach out to your school if your family is in need of any type of support.

Thank you for your patience and resilience, as we continue to plan for a safe return. Please know that we are working diligently to bring our students and staff back to school safely. We will continue to evaluate and monitor in order to make the best decisions for all of our students, staff and families regarding a safe in-person return to school.
