### **Office Managed Behaviors**

#### Intervention 1:

Call to notify office of major infraction, student to be picked up or sent to office.

-Write ODR



#### **Intervention 2:**

Student conference with administration.

Reflection/reteach/rehearse
behavior.



#### Intervention 3:

Administration determines and assigns consequences according to policy.



Intervention 4: Parent Contact (phone/ sheet) and administrator provides teacher with feedback. Input incident into Synergy

- All office managed behaviors require parent notification.
- If behavior continues and interventions are not modifying behaviors administrator will call for an intervention meeting with student and parents refers to SIP or implement Tier II and III Strategies.
- Every quarter (nine weeks) weeks starts with a clean slate.
- Take concrete action to correct behavior (i.e. individual practice, removal from activity, seat change, etc.
- Teachers are encouraged to use preventative strategies including strategies from Fred Jones Positive Classroom Discipline, Harry Wong-"First Days of School", Effective Elements of instruction, etc.
