Dear Roosevelt Community,

I wanted to connect with you to share these important updates and to remind you that we are all in this together -- as one Roosevelt Community.

Updates:

Beginning Friday, our District will distribute packets for four-weeks' worth of English Language Arts and Math practice. The packets will be available for all grade levels. Please note, students with special needs will receive 1:1 virtual or telephonic contact from their teachers to tailor the content to their needs. These packets are in addition to the learning resources (<https://www.rsd66.org/learningresources>) already listed on our website. District and Campus Administrators will distribute the packets at school sites during the breakfast and lunch meal distribution timeframe (<https://www.rsd66.org/mobile-meals>) which is 9 - 10:30 a.m. The learning packets will also be distributed to students on the mobile meals bus routes (between 10 a.m. and Noon beginning this Friday and continuing next week. In addition, individual campuses will also make packets available during other times to accommodate families.

Today our team served more than 6,000 meals to our students! Our Transportation and our Child Nutrition departments have been diligently working together on a daily basis to provide meals to our students during this school closure. Please note: Due to Cesar Chavez Holiday on Monday, meal distribution will begin on Tuesday, March 31 next week.

Many families have asked about WiFi and connectivity. We've been working with Cox Communication to pre-approve all students at Roosevelt for 60 days of free Cox WiFi. This means families will not have to submit any documentation to prove their qualification. Families can complete an application at Cox's Connect to Compete website- <http://www.cox.com/c2c>.

As a reminder, all AZ Schools continue to remain closed through at least April 10th, 2020.

We are a resilient community and we'll get through this together – one day at a time.

Querida Comunidad de Roosevelt,

Me comunico con ustedes para compartirles noticias importantes, a la misma vez recordarles que seguimos unidos como una sola comunidad en Roosevelt.

Actualizaciones:

Iniciando el viernes, nuestro distrito estará distribuyendo paquetes para cuatro semanas de práctica para inglés, artes y matemáticas. Los paquetes estarán disponibles para todos los grados. Por favor recuerde que los estudiantes con necesidades especiales estarán recibiendo contacto 1:1 ya sea virtualmente o por teléfono por parte de sus maestros para adaptar el contenido a sus necesidades. Estos paquetes son adicionales a los recursos de aprendizaje <https://www.rsd66.org/learningresources>

Que ya están en nuestro sitio web. Los administradores del distrito y de las escuelas estarán distribuyendo los paquetes en cada escuela durante las horas de distribución del desayuno y comida, el cual es de 9 a 10:30 a.m. Los paquetes de aprendizaje también serán distribuidos por los autobuses en las rutas de entrega de comidas- <https://www.rsd66.org/mobile-meals> entre las 10 a.m. y el medio día iniciando este viernes y continuando la próxima semana. Adicionalmente, de manera individual las escuelas también tendrán paquetes disponibles durante otros horarios para acomodar a las familias.

Hoy nuestro equipo sirvió más de 6,000 comidas a nuestros estudiantes, nuestros departamentos de transporte y nutrición infantil ha estado trabajando juntos a diario diligentemente para ofrecer comida a nuestros estudiantes durante este cierre escolar. Por favor tome en cuenta que la siguiente semana debido al aniversario de Cesar Chávez, cual esta designado como día de descanso, la distribución de las comidas iniciará el martes 31 de marzo.

Muchas familias han preguntado acerca del WiFi y como conectarse. Hemos estado trabajando con la compañía Cox Communications para aprobar a todos los estudiantes de Roosevelt por 60 días para obtener Cox Wifi gratis (ver cartel). Esto quiere decir que las familias no tendrán que entregar ningún documento que pruebe su elegibilidad. Las familias pueden completar una aplicación en el sitio web de Cox- <http://www.cox.com/c2c>

Como recordatorio, todas las escuelas en Arizona continuarán cerradas hasta el 10 de abril del 2020.

Nuestra comunidad es fuerte y pasaremos por esto juntos y unidos, un día a la vez.
