Dear Roosevelt Families,

As we prepare for Spring Break, we wanted to provide clarity around our learning plans for when we return. Earlier this week, we communicated our plan to have students choosing in-person learning return to campus on March 30.

After we shared our plans, the Governor released an executive order that requires any family that selected an in-person or hybrid learning option should have the opportunity to be back in classrooms following Spring Break. As a result of the new executive order, we have revised our return to school timeline and the in-person hybrid learning model will now begin on **Monday, March 22, 2021**.

Throughout this pandemic, we have prioritized the safety of our students, staff and families. We believe that it is important to have the week after spring break to appropriately prepare for the return of our amazing students.

Schools will be providing additional information for your student to return to an in-person hybrid learning setting. Please reach out to your child's school with any additional questions regarding learning plans after Spring Break.

Mientras nos preparamos para las vacaciones de primavera, queremos proporcionarles claramente nuestro plan de aprendizaje a partir de nuestro regreso.
