Dear Roosevelt Community,

Please be advised that **Roosevelt School District will continue to require face coverings indoors at all of our District sites.**

A [court ruling](#) yesterday determined that the Arizona ban on school face covering requirements is unconstitutional and will not go into effect on September 29 as previously announced. Although there will likely be an appeal to this ruling, RSD will keep all safety measures in place, including masking indoors. Currently, both the [Arizona Department of Health Services](#) and [Maricopa County Department of Public Health](#) metrics place our District in the “High Transmission” category, and we believe that continuing to require indoor masking will help keep our entire community safe, along with continuing to follow our District’s [Mitigation Plan](#).

What this means:

- Face coverings will continue to be required indoors at all of our district sites
- Face coverings will continue to be required on school buses and District transportation, per a [standing federal order](#)

We strongly encourage all students and staff to follow the [recommended guidelines from the Center for Disease Control \(CDC\)](#) to fight the spread of COVID-19 in our communities. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Taking advantage of [vaccine opportunities](#), if you are eligible
- Practicing physical distancing to the extent possible
- Practicing proper hygiene and being mindful of your own personal space

We appreciate your support and look forward to continuing a positive and safe school year.

Estimada Familias de Roosevelt,

Tenga en cuenta que el Distrito Escolar de Roosevelt seguirá requiriendo que se cubra la cara en el interior de todos los sitios escolares del distrito.

Un [fallo de la corte](#) determinó ayer que la prohibición de Arizona sobre los requisitos para cubrir las caras escolares es inconstitucional y no entrará en vigencia el 29 de septiembre como se anunció anteriormente. Aunque probablemente habrá una apelación a esta decisión, por el momento, RSD mantendrá todas las medidas de seguridad en su lugar, incluido el enmascaramiento en el interior.

Actualmente, tanto [el Departamento de Servicios de Salud de Arizona](#) como las métricas [del Departamento de Salud Pública del Condado de Maricopa](#) colocan a nuestro Distrito en la categoría de "Alta Transmisión", y creemos que continuar requiriendo enmascaramiento en interiores ayudará a mantener segura a toda nuestra comunidad, además de seguir cumpliendo [el Plan de Mitigación de Salud](#) de nuestro Distrito.

Lo que esto significa:

- Se seguirá requiriendo cubrirse la cara en el interior de todos nuestros sitios escolares del distrito.
- Se seguirán requiriendo cubrimientos faciales en los autobuses escolares y el transporte del Distrito, según [una orden federal](#) vigente.

Recomendamos encarecidamente a todos los estudiantes y al personal que sigan [las pautas recomendadas por el Centro para el Control de Enfermedades \(CDC\)](#) para combatir la propagación de COVID-19 en nuestras comunidades. Esto incluye, pero no se limita a:

- Aprovechar [las oportunidades de vacunas](#), si es elegible
- Practicar el distanciamiento físico en la medida de lo posible
- Practicar una higiene adecuada y ser consciente de su propio espacio personal.
